Prize Ratio: Minimum of 1 in 10 entries (\$1019 First Place Prize, based on 104 entries in each division)

Tournament Rules

1. Eligible participants who are not USBC Members can qualify, prior to participation, in one of two ways:

- By paying the appropriate association membership dues.
- By paying a participation fee (Rule 300c).

2. Multiple entries will be allowed, however, bowlers may only place once per weekly round and place once in Overall Finals.

a. Weekly Rounds (per division):

Each weekly round will consist of 3 games of qualifying across 3 pairs of lanes. The top four in each weekly round will advance to weekly finals which will take place on Tuesdays at 6:30pm. The winner of each weekly round will earn a berth in the Overall Finals. Bowlers who qualify for weekly finals must be present on Tuesday at the beginning of the weekly finals, or an alternate will take their place. Bowlers who do not earn an Overall Finals berth in a weekly round, can secure an at large berth, which will be awarded to the next highest overall qualifying series. In order to encourage early entry, the top four qualifiers during the first weekly round will earn an Overall Finals Berth.

b. Overall Finals (per division):

Weekly finalists may only earn one berth for Overall Finals. At-large berths will be used to fill any unearned Overall Finals berths based on best overall qualifying series. Overall Finals will consist of two games total pins matches in a 16-bowler tournament bracket.

c. All balls must be delivered in a timely manner. One-lane courtesy rule will be in effect.

3. There will be three divisions:

- a. Open Scratch (Entering average 200 and higher).
- b. Handicap (Entering average 199 and below). Handicap will be based on 90% of 200.

4. Entering average:

- a. 2009-2010 highest USBC average of 21 or more games.
- b. If no 2009-2010 average, use highest current USBC average at time of entry for 21 or more games (average verification required).
- c. Bowlers with neither of the above averages must bowl Open Scratch division.

5. It is each bowler's responsibility to verify their own average, whether originally submitted by the bowler or others. Failure to use the correct average may disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the correct average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average, if it is higher than the correct average (Rule 319a, item 3).

6. Reporting of previous tournament winnings will not apply (Rule 319d). The average adjustment rule will not apply (Rule 319e).

7. Conduct detrimental to the sport.

a. All participants are expected to show courtesy, sportsmanship, and convey a professional image for the event. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the event without refund of entry fee, and/or suspension from future events, at discretion of tournament management.

b. There will be zero tolerance for dishonest play and cheating. Failure to comply may result in disqualification without refund of entry fee and/or suspension from future events, at discretion of tournament management.

8. Dress Code.

a. None of the following attire will be permitted (at discretion of tournament management): Jeans, Draw strings, parachute type pants, cut-offs, t-shirts, sports jerseys and/or items that hang or protrude from apparel.

b. Furthermore, dress shorts will be permitted, and earrings will be allowed if they are in good taste.

c. All bowlers are expected to convey a clean professional image for the tournament. Unprofessional and/or ragged appearance will not be allowed to compete.

9. All decisions of the tournament manager are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
